SUBJECT: **SECURITY CLEARANCE CERTIFICATE (NOC).**

I am directed to refer to your letter No. 04877, dated 04th September 2020 on the subject and to state that the Competent Authority is pleased to grant Security Clearance Certificate (NOC) in favour of Khwendo Kor for their project titled "Livelihood Support & Promotion of Small Community Infrastructure Programme (LACIP)" in Upper Dir, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa for a period of six months from 03-11-2020 to 02-05-2021 on the following terms & conditions:-

- a. Staff of your NGO/Organizations are NOT allowed to work in areas/sectors other than specified in your request.
- b. Go/No go Areas be clearly spelled out to the staff of your NGO/Organization.
- c. No geological, seismic and other type of survey is allowed.
- d. Use of Wireless equipment, surveillance devices, intelligence gathering are disallowed to staff of your Organization/UN bodies.
- e. Proper security/protection may be ensured during stay and also field visits.
- f. The movement of the individuals may be limited only to work plan/schedule. -
- g. The visit plan of the individuals may be communicated to all concerned in advance.
- h. Movement and stay, where applicable, shall be proper coordinated by the respective Divisional/District Administrations/Police authorities.
- i. Visiting staff/persons shall not visit restricted areas/installations.
- j. No Photography of sensitive and restricted areas.
- k. District Administration concerned shall ensure that visit may be undertaken only in the area where rehabilitation activities are assisted by UN agencies, if any.
- l. Police Security cover be provided to avoid any untoward incident.
- m. Visit to areas located in close proximity to Newly Merged Frontier Regions (FR) with the District concerned, if any, is NOT allowed.

- n. Visit to areas situated up to 10 KMs distance near to the International border, wherever applicable, is NOT allowed.
- o. The visit is allowed subject to possession of valid travelling documents including Passport, Pakistan Visa as well as CNICs (in case of Pakistani Nationals) and valid MoU/Work NOC duly issued by the competent authority in the relevant field, wherever applicable.
- p. Visit to all prohibited places falling in or outside cantonments in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa is NOT allowed.
- q. Visit to isolated cantonments is NOT allowed.
- r. Visit to Cantonments merging with civil areas excluding the Roads, Market areas, civil.
- s. Visit to all important installations which have been specifically sign-posted as "Prohibited Areas", is NOT allowed.
- t. Visit to Areas specifically declared as "**Restricted**" is NOT allowed.
- u. Visit to Pakistan Armed Forces, installations is NOT allowed.
